REFLECT & RESPOND



THE LORD'S SUPPER is the act of remembering Jesus for what he accomplished by dying on the cross for our sins. Jesus asked his followers to remember that his body was broken and his blood was shed as he took the punishment for our sin.

You don't have to be a member of Turning Point to participate. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord then you are welcome to join us in celebrating the Lord's Table. But the Bible gives us two warnings. First, we should not do this in an unworthy manner. Please take time to pray and prepare your hearts. Confess any sin you are aware of and begin to focus your thoughts on the Lord. Secondly, the Bible is clear that this ceremony is for Christians, so if you are not a Christian yet, we would ask that you refrain from taking the elements, unless today you desire to commit yourself to become a follower of Jesus.

Becoming a Christian is an act of surrendering your life completely to God, confessing your belief that you need forgiveness, that Jesus came to this earth to die for your sin, that he rose again from the dead and that he is coming again. You don't have to understand all of the Bible, but you need a sincere desire to become a follower of Jesus, doing your best to learn what pleases him and committing yourself to a life of loving obedience. If you would like to know more about becoming a follower of Jesus please talk with a Christian friend or one of the pastors. Please pick up a free Bible at the Info Table in the back. Our website also has info on how to become a Christian (see "Resources" tab).

PLEASE FEEL FREE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY OF THESE AREAS:

1. There are 2 tables with bread and cups (grape juice) for you to celebrate the Lord's supper. When you're ready please feel free to gather at those tables and serve yourself. Approach the table when you are ready and eat a piece of bread and drink from individual cups (Note: If there is one large cup then simply dip your piece of bread in the cup before you eat it.)
2. Prayer Area: There will be a pastor or other leader (in the back) ready to pray for you if you desire prayer for yourself or for someone else. Please feel free to approach them with your requests.
3. Offering: Take a moment at the offering table to thank God for his many blessings and to worship him by giving back a portion of what he has given you. You can also put your "Feedback" form in the basket.
4. Stay in your seat and reflect on how you will respond to what you have heard today. Enjoy the music. Write a response on your "Growing Point."



Got coffee? We invite you to grab a cup and anything else at the refreshment table that looks good to you. Relax and enjoy a conversation with someone. We're glad you came today and hope that it will be an enjoyable and meaningful experience. We get together to honor God for who he is and for the many amazing things he's done. We worship God through songs, prayer and sharing and spend time studying the Bible which we believe God inspired to help us know him and how he wants us to live.

Babies (0 to sitting/crawling) 9:00 & 11:00 services: TPC has set aside a place in the nursery (Room 8) for moms with babies. A screened-in area with a rocking chair, changing table and a baby monitor to listen to the message is available. Babies are always welcome in our services.

Toddlers (sitting/crawling to 35mo) 9:00 & 11:00 services: Our toddler room (Room 8) is staffed by our nursery workers, Christina & Stephanie Horn, and by caring people who keep our equipment and toys clean and sanitized. Background checks are done on all workers. Please respect others by not putting your child in the toddler room if they are sick.

Preschool to 5th grade: Meet in the Library (upper level) during second service. Classes start around 11:30, when children are dismissed from the main service.

Youth - Sunday classes for Middle School and High School students meet on the 1st and 3rd Sundays in Room 5 (lower level). Youth group meets weekly on Tuesdays usually at the Lacey Community Center.
