Entry Point 1

DO I FIT?

This class helps answer the question, “Do I fit?” There are a number of good churches in the area and it’s important that you determine which one is the best fit for you. DO I QUIT?

Hopefully you'll answer this question in the negative, but unfortunately many Christians get too comfortable and quit maturing like they should. Paul pointed this out:

Though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! ¹³ Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. ¹⁴ But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil. [Hebrews 5:12-14]

Once you've completed Entry Point 2 you're eligible to join B.O.L.D.
