HIS KIDS CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Helping kids know and love Jesus!

The Nursery is available during 2nd service at 10:30 am

Nursery (ages 1 through 4 years old): Children in this age group meet in His Kids Room 2 (lower level). Nursery opens at 10:25 am for second service. The lessons begin after children are dismissed from the Main Room. Please respect our wellness policy by keeping your child out of the nursery if he/she exhibits any symptom of illness.

Classes available during 2nd service at 10:30 am:

K through 2nd grade: This class meets downstairs in Room 1. The class begins after children are dismissed from the Main Room - please escort your child to the classroom at that time.

3rd - 5th grades: Children in this age group will meet in the Lobby after children are dismissed from the Main Room. They will follow their teacher up the stairs to His Kids Room 8-9 (upper level)

Note to Parents: Children's staff are adults who passed background checks. For security purposes, all children in all His Kids classes must be checked in where they will receive a name tag and a coded sticker per child. (Pagers are issued upon the parents' request.) Please do this before service. When picking up children from the Nursery, Preschool and Primary classes, please bring the sticker received at time of check-in. Children in each age-bracket will experience age-appropriate Sunday school programs.

Parents of Infants: The Mothers' Only Room is located upstairs (Room #4). This room is designed to provide privacy and a quiet, comfortable place where mothers can continue to see and hear the service while feeding their babies.
