LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Planting Truth in a Hostile Culture

1 Corinthians 1:1–9 (ESV)

Corinth was a wealthy, influential, and morally broken city, yet it was exactly there that God chose to plant a church. This opening message reminds us that the gospel does not wait for culture to improve before it works. God brings life into dark places, and where truth is planted, grace grows.

Paul's arrival in Corinth was not accidental but directed by God's sovereign purpose. Likewise, where we live and serve today is not random. God often places His people in difficult, even hostile, environments to display His power and faithfulness.

1. God's Calling Carries God's Authority Paul grounds his ministry not in personality or approval, but in God's calling. Faithfulness, not popularity, defines obedience.

2. Our Identity Is Rooted in Christ, Not Culture The church belongs to God, even while living in a broken world. Believers are sanctified in Christ and called saints before they ever act like it.

3. Spiritual Growth Flows from God's Grace Paul gives thanks for what God has already done. Grace is not only how the Christian life begins, it is how it continues.

4. Spiritual Gifts Must Be Governed by Truth and Love God had richly gifted the Corinthians, but gifts without maturity can divide rather than build up. Growth requires love and humility.

God Is Faithful to Sustain His People to the End The believers' security rests not in their performance but in God's faithfulness. The same God who calls His people will hold them fast until Christ returns.

As the series begins, we are reminded that no city is too dark, no church too messy, and no life too broken for the gospel. God is faithful, and where the gospel is planted, grace will grow.
