LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Trusting the Wisdom of God 1 Corinthians 3:18–23

In this passage, the Apostle Paul in First Corinthians calls believers to a radical shift in perspective: we must all learn to trust God's wisdom more than the wisdom of the world. In a culture that prizes intellect, status, and philosophical sophistication, Paul warns against self-deception and challenges us to evaluate what we truly consider wise.

1- We must all learn to trust God's wisdom more than the wisdom of the world.

First, we are called to **believe the truth** (v. 18). This requires discernment, recognizing error and measuring every idea against the unchanging standard of God's Word. Our source for truth is not cultural trends or human reasoning, but divine revelation. To become truly wise, we must be willing, in the world's eyes, to become "fools" who humbly submit to God.

2- We must believe in the truth of God's word.

Second, we learn what it means to **become wise** (vv. 19–20). Paul contrasts man's wisdom with God's wisdom. Worldly philosophies that reject the truth of God are ultimately empty and exposed before Him. What the world celebrates as brilliance, God sees clearly. True wisdom begins with reverence for God and alignment with His purposes.

3- We must recognize the foolishness of worldly philosophies that reject the truth of God.

Finally, we are reminded of our identity in **belonging to Christ** (vv. 21–23). Because all things ultimately belong to God and we belong to Christ, there is no room for boasting in human leaders. Our confidence rests in God's sovereignty. As we grow in relationship with Jesus Christ, we mature in genuine wisdom and find our security not in men, but in Him.

4- We will grow in true wisdom by having a relationship with Jesus.

In summary, Paul teaches us to believe God's Word, reject the foolishness of worldly thinking, and grow in true wisdom through a living relationship with Christ.
