ELDERS CORNER

The Physics of Light: A Brief Teaching

Light is a form of electromagnetic radiation, which means it's energy that travels in waves. What we call "visible light" is just a small slice of a much bigger spectrum that includes radio waves, microwaves, infrared, ultraviolet, X-rays, and gamma rays.

1. Light Travels in Waves

Light moves incredibly fast...about 299,792 kilometers per second (186,282 miles per second) in a vacuum.

These waves have different wavelengths, which determine the color of the light we see.

Red light = long wavelength

Blue/violet light = short wavelength

2. Light Can Act Like a Wave and a Particle

This is called wave-particle duality.

As a wave, light shows behaviors like reflection, refraction, and interference. As a particle, it's made of photons, tiny packets of energy that can knock electrons loose from atoms (which is how solar panels work!).

3. Light Interacts with Matter

It can be reflected (like in a mirror),

Refracted (bent, like when it passes through water or a prism),

Absorbed (like a black shirt in sunlight),

Or scattered (which is why the sky looks blue).

4. Spiritual Parallel: God Is Light

1 John 1:5 says, "God is light, and in him is no darkness at all." Just as physical light reveals what's hidden and guides our way, God's light exposes the truth, reveals sin, and leads us toward what is right. Without His light, we are lost in spiritual darkness.

When we step into His light, we see clearly ourselves, our sin, and His holiness. In that light, there is healing, forgiveness, and transformation. As we walk with Him, we're also called to reflect His light to others, just as the moon reflects the sun.

Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12). And in Matthew 5:14, He tells us, "You are the light of the world." We receive His light and shine it for others, pointing them to the Source.
