## LAST WEEK'S SERMON

### HONORING GOD IN MARRIAGE AND SINGLENESS

In 1 Corinthians 7:1–9, Paul addresses real-life questions about marriage, singleness, and sexuality with pastoral wisdom and theological clarity. In a culture marked by both indulgence and confusion, he calls believers to honor Christ with their bodies, reminding us that our identity in Him shapes how we live in every relationship and season of life.

#### **1: Pursue purity by embracing God's design for sexuality.**

Paul redirects the Corinthians from both cultural excess and spiritual extremes back to God's good design. Purity is not merely about avoiding sin, but about embracing a life ordered under Christ's authority. As believers trust God's design for intimacy within marriage, they discover that His boundaries are not restrictive, but protective and life-giving.

#### **2: Practice faithful and selfless love within your marriage.**

Marriage is presented as a covenant of mutual care, where both husband and wife give themselves in love. This selfless posture reflects the gospel, as each spouse seeks the flourishing of the other above personal preference. Faithful love requires intentionality, humility, and a daily commitment to serve, making marriage a visible expression of Christ's love.

#### **3. Receive your current calling as a gift and use it for God's Glory.**

Paul reminds us that both marriage and singleness are gifts from God, each with purpose in His kingdom. Rather than comparing or striving for a different circumstance, believers are called to embrace their present season with gratitude. Faithfulness in our calling becomes an act of worship as we live for God's glory right where He has placed us.

#### **4: Exercise Spirit-empowered self-control**

Acknowledging the reality of human desire, Paul points to the necessity of Spirit-enabled self-control. God provides both the strength and the structure to walk in obedience, whether through marriage or singleness. As we depend on the Holy Spirit, we are empowered to make decisions that honor Christ and lead to lasting spiritual maturity. Ultimately, this passage reminds us that whether married or single, the call is the same: to honor Christ with our bodies. Rooted in our identity in Him, we are invited to live lives of purity, faithfulness, and devotion, trusting that His grace is sufficient for every calling.
