ELDERS CORNER

Five Ways to "Test the Voices" This Week

- 1. **Filter your influences.** Ask: "Does this voice exalt the real Jesus or a counterfeit?" This includes media, books, and even Christian content.
- 2. **Stay anchored in Scripture.** The Word of God is your standard. Not feelings, not trends, not charisma.
- 3. **Walk in step with the Spirit.** Stay sensitive to the conviction, peace, and illumination of the Holy Spirit in your daily life.
- 4. Stay rooted in Christ-centered community. Don't isolate. You need other believers to help you test what is true.
- 5. **Stay humble and teachable.** Spiritual pride makes us vulnerable to deception. Keep asking God to show you truth.

Spiritual Growth Points to Take Home

- 1. **Discernment is a command, not a suggestion.** It's an active discipline, not a passive experience.
- 2. The confession of Christ is the center of the test. If a spirit or message denies Jesus' incarnation, it's not from God. No matter how appealing it sounds.
- 3. You are an overcomer because Christ lives in you. You're not fighting for victory but from it.
- 4. **Truth and error are spiritually sourced.** There is a spirit behind every message.
- 5. Your life will follow the voice you trust. The direction of your soul is shaped by the voices you believe.

In a world filled with competing voices, some subtle, others loud, we are not left helpless. God has equipped us with His Word, His Spirit, and His people to help us discern what is true. As you go into this week, don't let your guard down.
