LAST WEEK'S SERMON

Worshipping God Alone

1 Corinthians 10:14–33

In this passage, Paul calls believers to examine what truly has first place in their hearts. The Christian life is not simply about avoiding obvious sin; it is about wholehearted devotion to God. Through practical instruction about idolatry, Christian liberty, and daily conduct, Paul reminds us that every area of life should be shaped by a desire to honor Christ and bring glory to Him.

1. God wants to focus all of our worship on Him!

God alone is worthy of our worship, affection, and devotion. While most believers would never bow before a physical idol, many things can compete for God's place in our hearts. Paul reminds us that worship is never neutral. God calls His people to center their lives completely on Him.

2. Making God the center of all of our worship. (Vs. 14-21)

Paul commands believers to flee from idolatry because worship involves genuine spiritual participation. We cannot walk in fellowship with Christ while clinging to the things of darkness. Keeping God first requires intentional choices and a willingness to remove anything that competes with Him. True worship flows from a heart that is fully devoted to the Lord.

3. Freedom to make Godly choices. (Vs. 23-30)

Christian freedom is a wonderful gift, but it must always be guided by love. Paul teaches that believers should not simply ask what is permissible but what is beneficial and helpful to others. As we interact with unbelievers and navigate everyday situations, God's Word provides principles that help us make wise, loving, and Christ-honoring decisions.

4. Freedom to glorify God for everything. (Vs. 31-33)

The ultimate purpose of the Christian life is the glory of God. Whether in worship, work, relationships, or ordinary daily activities, believers are called to honor Him. God is the source of every blessing and the resource for every need. As we seek His glory above our own interests, our lives become powerful testimonies that point others to Christ.

Paul concludes this section by reminding us that worship is much bigger than what happens on Sunday. Every choice, every relationship, and every opportunity becomes a chance to glorify God. As followers of Christ, may we seek to worship Him alone, love others well, and live each day for His glory.
