ELDERS CORNER

God's Steadfast and Covenant-Faithful Love in the Old Testament

The Old Testament reveals God's love as steadfast, faithful, and covenantal. The Hebrew word *hesed* speaks of loyal, enduring mercy—not earned, but flowing from God's character.

From creation, God lovingly forms humanity (Genesis 1–2). Even after sin enters the world, He pursues redemption, not abandonment.

In His covenant with Israel, His love stands out. Deuteronomy 7:7–8 (ESV) says:

"It was not because you were more in number... but it is because the Lord loves you and is keeping the oath that he swore to your fathers..."

God's love is grounded in promise, not performance.

The Psalms celebrate His enduring love. Psalm 136:1 (ESV):

"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever."

Even when Israel fails, God's love remains. In Hosea 11:8 (ESV), God cries:

"How can I give you up, O Ephraim?... My compassion grows warm and tender."

And in Isaiah 54:10 (ESV):

"For the mountains may depart... but my steadfast love shall not depart from you..."

In the Old Testament, God's love is a powerful, steadfast force. It is rooted in covenant, expressed in mercy, and shown through patience, compassion, and faithfulness. His love endures, even when His people falter, always calling them back to restoration and life.

This steadfast, covenantal love of God in the Old Testament finds its fullest expression in the New Testament through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
