## LAST WEEK'S SERMON

### **Blessed in Christ**

Ephesians 1:1-14 (ESV)

Big Idea: God has chosen, redeemed, and sealed us in Christ.

Paul opens his letter to the Ephesians not with fear or warnings, but with an overflow of praise. In one long sentence, he celebrates the blessings that belong to believers "in Christ." These blessings are not earthly or temporary, but spiritual and eternal, secured by the Father, the Son, and the Spirit.

Paul reminds the church that:

- 1. Remember Who You Are (v. 1–2) We are saints, set apart in Christ, recipients of grace and peace. Our identity is rooted not in our past but in our position in Him.
- 2. **Rest in the Father's Love** (v. 3–6) Before creation, God chose us in Christ and predestined us for adoption as His children. Our salvation begins with His love, not our works.
- 3. Live in the Freedom of Christ's Redemption (v. 7–12) Through Christ's blood, we have redemption and forgiveness. Sin no longer defines us, for we have been set free and given an eternal inheritance.

**Walk with Confidence in Christ Jesus** (v. 13–14) The Holy Spirit seals us as God's own and guarantees our future inheritance. We belong to Him forever.

From beginning to end, salvation is God's work: chosen by the Father, redeemed by the Son, sealed by the Spirit, all "to the praise of His glory."
